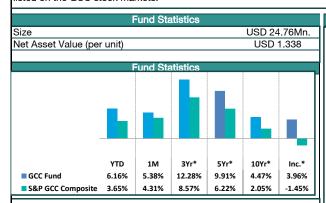

Commentary

Market Update:

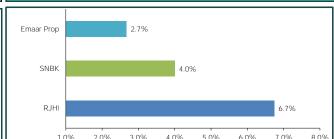
In February, the majority of GCC markets concluded positively, mirroring the global financial market trend. The S&P GCC Sharia index notably rose by 4.3% during the month, while oil prices sustained their upward movement, ending the month with a 2.3% gain.

Saudi Tadawul led the pack as the best-performing market in February, achieving a significant 7.1% gain. Following closely were Qatar and Dubai markets, with gains of 3.8% and 3.4% respectively. Kuwait All Share Index also exhibited positive momentum, recording a 2.4% gain. However, Bahrain experienced the largest decline at 3.0% loss, with Abu Dhabi and Oman declining marginally.

The fund performed well during the month , registering a 5.4% gain during February, outperforing the S&P GCC benchmark by 1.07%. Going forrward, we anticipate regional markets benefiting from stabilized oil prices due to geopolitical tensions and ongoing oil cuts by OPEC+. We remain committed to our defensive strategy amidst ongoing dividend distributions.

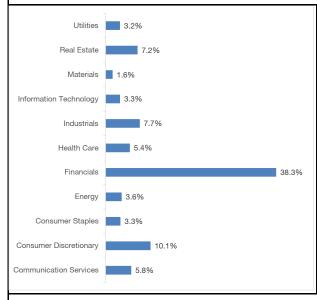

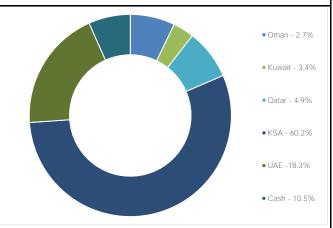
